- Welcome to U3A Inner North! This is now your U3A so please participate as much as you can. We hope you enjoy being a member, and if you'd ever like to tutor/lead a class/activity let us know.
- Please read all your **emails** thoroughly and carefully. Email is our major method of communication and we don't want you to miss anything!
- Your **Member Portal** is where you maintain your contact details, view and enrol in class and communicate with your Tutor/Leader. Please ensure you register in the Member Portal as soon as possible as per your Welcome email.
 - You can register using your member number or email address, however if you share your email address with another U3A member you will both need to use only your membership number.
 - You only need to register in the [Member Portal](#) once and thereafter you can log on and access the class schedules and other options.

- Photos are taken at classes/activities and events. If you do not wish to be in photos, please alert the photographer and/or move away from the shot.
- **Name badges** should be worn to every session. Plastic badges are free and you can print your own from the system or request one from membership@u3ainnernorth.org.au. Additionally, if you would like a smaller hard plastic magnetic badge look out for an email in Feb/March and reply if you would like one – these are usually around \$10 each.
- **Medical Emergencies:**
Members are advised to have suitable **ambulance cover**. In the event of collapse or sudden illness U3A policy is to call an ambulance. U3AIN will not cover costs involved.

Please note that when involved in U3AIN activities/classes it is your responsibility to carry medical and/or emergency information on your person and/or have a medic alert bracelet etc. to assist first aiders/ ambulance officers.

Your emergency contact person registered with U3AIN will be contacted as appropriate and as soon as possible. It is recommended that they are aware of your **pre-existing medical conditions** to assist with your medical care.

- **Membership Fees**
 - Membership fees can be paid via your [Member Portal](#) or the invoice sent to you. You can pay by card, or bank transfer, or cash.
 - If you are paying by cash, please bring the correct amount along to the in-person enrolment day in January, or during terms on Wednesdays 9.30am to 10.30am - ask for Jude in the Hall.
 - Your membership fees must be paid in full before you attend any classes/activities.

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• Class/Activities

- You can enrol in classes online via your [Member Portal](#) from 5th January 2026. In-person enrolment Day for members unable to complete this online, is on 12th January 2025 at Enfield Community Centre 10.00 to 12pm. Please check the program beforehand and come along with your list so we can process your enrolment quickly.
- Your **membership fees must be paid in full before you attend any classes/activities.**
- Once enrolled in a class you will receive a confirmation email, and you will see these listed in your Member Portal.
- If the class is full, you can join the waitlist. You will receive an email when a spot becomes free.
- If you are **unable to attend a class/activity**, please update your attendance to the system but if it's close/on the date, please contact your tutor/leader directly as well.
- Please **arrive on time** and leave promptly at the end of your session, out of courtesy to the groups before or after your session. Please help to tidy up at the end of the session.
- Check with your tutor if your class includes a tea break and if so, please bring your own mug etc.
- Most classes operate in terms as below, however there are some exceptions so please check your class/activity details carefully.

Term 1 - 09 February to 10 April
Term 2 - 27 April to 03 July
Term 3 - 20 July to 25 September
Term 4 - 12 October to 11 December

- Most Class are held at the Enfield Community Centre (ECC), however there are some exceptions so please check your class/activity details carefully.
- Hot Weather Policy - Classes may be cancelled if the forecast temperature (as at 6pm on the preceding day) is 38°C or above, at the discretion of the tutor or group leader.
